Fellowship Program Description

Purpose: To provide recent graduates who exemplified the spirit of hospitality and fine dining with the opportunity to further their learning of, and experience in, hospitality and business operations.

Program Description: This program provides a fellowship opportunity to a graduate of Walnut Hill College or a comparable international institution who exemplifies the spirit of hospitality and displays superior academic ability. Fellows will be selected on the basis of demonstrated achievement and exceptional promise. The fellowship program will involve working within one of the college departments such as Dining Room Services, Culinary or Pastry Operations, or another area of the business. The fellow will work directly with the appropriate director or a designee thereof.

Fellowship Work Hours: The fellow can expect to complete a 40 hour work week during operational hours and be available during special school events. Weekend availability a must. Additionally, the fellow should expect to work during all scheduled student breaks with the exception of school recognized holidays and closures.

Tasks and Duties: Tasks and duties of the Fellow will vary by department, however, of utmost importance is upholding the College Mission, Values and Philosophies as it relates to education and hospitality.

Qualifications:

- Graduate of Walnut Hill College Baccalaureate Degree or comparable international program.
- Strong organizational, technical, and guest service skills.
- Professional, polite manner for dealing with public as well as students and directing staff.
- Training and teaching skills.

Supervised by: Assigned Departmental Director(s)

Program Pay: Fellows accepted to the program will receive payment of \$25,000 prorated weekly over the four term assignment. Fellows successfully completing the full 4-terms without interruption are eligible for a one-time \$5000 bonus at the completion of the assignment. Graduates are eligible to complete one fellowship, however, consideration may be made for exemplary Fellows to complete an additional Advanced Fellowship.
